

Our last season was a huge hit and we can't wait to kick off the season for 2024.



## Noises Off

### THE OTAUTAHI MUSICAL THEATRE SHOW

**ZYLPHA HARRISON** 

In the vibrant tapestry of Showbiz Christchurch's history, one figure has woven herself seamlessly into its fabric for over half a century, Zylpha Harrison, a stalwart member since 1970. Little did she know then that her involvement would become a cherished legacy spanning 54 years and counting. Now, after four decades of dedicated service as the society's honorary historian, Zylpha Harrison is gracefully transitioning from her role, leaving behind a treasure trove of memories and an unparalleled contribution to the Showbiz story.

How did your journey with Showbiz Christchurch begin? What initially drew you to the organisation?

I got involved with Showbiz in 1970 in the production of The Sound Of Music. I played one of the nuns! I've been involved with the organisation ever since! 54 years and counting.

What roles or positions have you held within Showbiz Christchurch throughout your years of involvement?

As well as performing on stage, I've been secretary, production secretary, have worked in wardrobe, I've been on the committee and executive and I have a role on the trust. I took on the role of Historian in 1984, so have been in that role for 40 years. Bruce Pearce, who was our musical director for a while, held the role before me. It is with mixed emotion that I hand the reins over to someone else moving forward, but I can't lift the heavy boxes of programmes anymore!

Could you share some memorable moments or highlights from your time with Showbiz Christchurch?

I loved being involved in Fiddler On The Roof in 1982, the first one Showbiz staged. I was a flying ghost and got to sit on the shoulders of Bruce Pearce, who was a big solid man, but couldn't see very well!

At one stage I was on his shoulders and he was heading straight for the orchestra pit! Thankfully Peter Simmonds saw where we were headed and skilfully steered Bruce in the right direction. The audience has no idea but I'm sure the cast and orchestra were holding their breath.







#### OUR PEOPLE Celebrating the heroes of Showbiz Christchurch



How have you seen Showbiz Christchurch evolve or change over the years?

The biggest change is in the size of the organisation. When I joined there was only an administrator and the executive. We would produce one show a year when I started. Now there's a team of people working on our shows and we produce up to three shows a year. It's been wonderful watching the organisation grow and reach a larger audience over the years. Having the input of the consortium has really changed things. We couldn't do what we do without them. It really changed the organisation and helped us to move into the future. It certainly takes an army to achieve what we do.

How has your involvement with Showbiz Christchurch influenced or enriched your personal or professional life?

Music has become the biggest part of my life throughout my time with Showbiz Christchuch. It's been wonderful to be so involved with the society and to keep music as a major part of my life.

Are there any specific people or colleagues at Showbiz Christchurch whom you would like to acknowledge or express gratitude toward?

The list goes on and on. Peter Simmonds, May Arnold and Sue Beardsley have been incredible members of the trust over the years. Sue is still involved and having a huge impact. I've very much enjoyed working with them all.

As you reflect on your time with Showbiz Christchurch, what legacy or impact do you hope to have left behind?

As Showbiz historian, I have thoroughly enjoyed recording the history of the society and looking at all the old programmes and images over the years. Especially when I looked into Diane Brodie's history with Showbiz. I had to have a good dig through the archives when Diane won her award which I found incredibly interesting.

I am proud of the fact that all our archives are in order and the history of the society has been kept in tack. Our records date back to 1938, and there is only one programme missing from our archives from that year. That's a pretty great accomplishment. If you happen to have a programme from *The Belle Of The Ball*, please drop one in!

As Zylpha passes the torch of Showbiz Christchurch's historian, her departure from this particular role marks the end of an era filled with dedication, passion, and a profound love for music and theatre. Her contributions, spanning from performing on stage to meticulously documenting the society's rich history, have left an indelible mark. Let us extend our heartfelt gratitude to Zylpha Harrison for her unwavering commitment and invaluable service to Showbiz Christchurch. While she may bid farewell to her official historian role, we are grateful that she continues to be an integral part of our organisation through her involvement in the trust.











Linda Harris

What's your current role here at Showbiz, and what's the most exciting part about it?

I am the Wardrobe Manager for *Kinky Boots*. For this show the most exciting thing has been all the wonderful boots. So much glitter and so many colours and styles.

Tell us a bit about your experience working with Showbiz.

I have been involved with Showbiz now for about 8-9 years. The best show I have worked on was my very first show, *Pricilla Queen Of The Desert*. There were 16 cast members and 64 crew looking after them. There were over 200 head pieces and wigs and I lost count of the quick changes. I was thrown in the deep end and was part of a quick change on one of the leads. We had a total of 40 seconds to get him out of his zipped up swimsuit, high heeled flippers, long gloves and flowered swim cap and we had to dress him in an evening dress, long gloves,, apply red lipstick and glitter on his lips and fit high heeled shoes on his feet. It was magic! It was my first show and I have never experienced that same challenge since or the level of adrenaline rush that show gave us. It was a work out and I loved every minute.

What do you enjoy the most about working with the wider team at Showbiz?

There are so many wonderful people who have been involved for many years. Working in the sewing room with them is so interesting. I hear about all their stories and their experiences on stage.

When you're not immersed in the world of musicals, what do you enjoy doing in your free time?

I love spending time with my family. When I'm not watching my children's endeavours, I sew. I love creating exciting looks. I sew for the Entertainment Company and have created many exciting costumes. Show girl costumes, giant flower dresses and exotic looks. I also volunteer at The Canterbury Children's Theatre doing their costumes for their shows. My favourite one is the Harry Potter themed party. Dobby was my biggest pride as the children love him.

What motivates you to continue pursuing your passion for musical theatre, even on the toughest days?

Magic happens on stage. I love storytelling through song. I love the exciting dance numbers and the music. Everything about it feels exciting. Every production is different and I love it!











**OLIVIA CHUNN** 

What's your current role here at Showbiz, and what's the most exciting part about it?

My current role here at Showbiz will be a shared role of production secretary. The most exciting part about this role is that I'll be able to watch the production grow from the very early stages right up until it hits the stage. This will be my first time working with Showbiz and I am actually interning here as part of my final semester of my Event Management degree at Ara. While working here I look forward to gaining valuable insights and hands-on experience, contributing to the success of the production while further developing event management skills.

What do you enjoy the most about working with the wider team at Showbiz?

Meeting new creative people that I can learn from and be a part of a community that shares the same passion for the performing arts.

What's something surprising or unique about the world of musical productions that most people might not know?

While I haven't specifically worked on musical productions, my experience as a dancer for many years has given me insight into the busy and chaotic scenes that unfold backstage and in the wings. It's essentially a whole other show going on behind the scenes that the audience will never see.

When you're not immersed in study or the world of musicals, what do you enjoy doing in your free time?

Some of my favourite hobbies include travelling, reading, and staying active with Pilates and Zumba. Additionally, I find joy in utilising my event skills through volunteering at various events in Christchurch. Last year, I had the opportunity to contribute to exciting initiatives such as the Fast5 Netball Series, New Zealand International Film Festival, Innovation Expo, and the Dress for Success charity fashion show.

What motivates you to continue pursuing your passion for musical theatre, even on the toughest days?

Understanding that each day brings its own unique experiences and viewing challenges as opportunities for personal growth. My passion for being a part of the performing arts world itself is enough of a motivator.
